Acknowledgement of the Laws and Regulations Pertaining to the District's Integrated Pest Management Program

As mandated by the State of Texas, through the Structural Pest Control Service of the Texas Department of Agriculture, the [insert district name] Independent School District has a policy adopted by the School Board regarding pesticide application to any and all facilities, including buildings, landscape, and athletic fields.

Specifically, all pesticide applications shall be performed by state-licensed technicians and/or applicators under the direct supervision of the District's Integrated Pest Management Coordinator (IPMC). A pesticide is defined as any product utilized to suppress insects (insecticide), unwanted vegetation (herbicide), mice/ rat infestation (rodenticide), termites (termicide), and diseases of plants (fungicide).

The participation of volunteer parent groups in helping to maintain our campuses is greatly appreciated and aids the District staff in countless ways through beautification and repairs. It is the responsibility of ALL volunteer groups to be aware of the District's IPM Program, which can be found on the District's website, through the District's IPM Coordinator, or through the Texas Department of Agriculture's website.

The volunteer group shall designate a parent contact whose signature below acknowledges that they:

1. Have read the District's IPM policy and will ensure that ALL volunteers under the direction of the parent contact are also aware of the policy and that all aspects of the policy are strictly enforced;
2. Shall coordinate and communicate with the Facilities Maintenance Director through the use of the District's SchoolDude work-order process, issues for which pesticides may be applied, under the direction of the district IPM Coordinator;
3. Shall inform the District that they will no longer be the parent contact and will notify the parent contact designate of the signature requirement for this acknowledgement form.

A copy of this form shall be kept in the campus IPM notebook and with the IPM Coordinator.
